The human body is the temple of the Holy Spirit and should be cared for in a manner pleasing to the Lord. (1 Cor. 10:31)

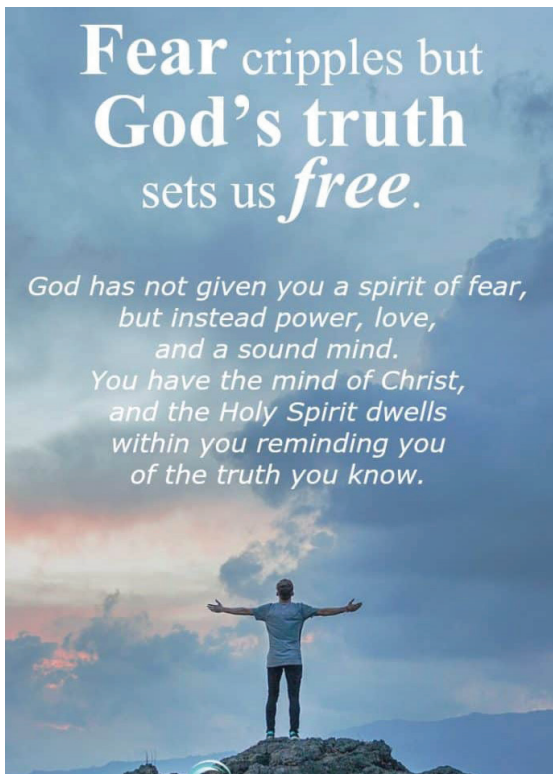
Life choices should be governed by Biblical principles. (Phil. 2:5-8)
